

- Units must be constructed of natural granite or marble stone.
- Dimensions: Height -- Units cannot exceed forty two (42) inches measured from the highest point of finished grade level on the footing. Width --A single unit may not exceed forty eight (48) inches. --A double unit may not exceed ninety six (96) inches. Length---Units cannot exceed ninety six (96) inches.
- Plot size: Single units must be centered on two plots with combined dimensions of at least eight feet in width by eight feet in length (8' x 8'). Double units must be centered on three plots with combined dimensions of at least twelve feet in width by eight feet in length (12' x 8').

# Cemetery Rules And Regulations

# RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MAIN STREET UNITED METHODIST CHURCH CEMETERY

All matters pertaining to the cemetery not covered in the items below must be brought to the attention of the Cemetery Committee for consideration of the Church Council.

- Burial plots are available to members of Main Street United Methodist Church and to members of their families.
- The reservation fee for each burial plot is \$500.00 and must be paid in full at the time of assignment. A certificate of assignment will be presented to the assignee by the church office upon receipt of full payment. The reservation fee for burial plots may be changed by action of the Church Council.
- Burial plots are to be used by the person or persons to whom they are assigned and are not transferable. If the assigned burial plots are not used by the person or persons to whom they are assigned, they must be returned to the church for reassignment. The Church does not make cash reimbursements for plots returned to the Church. A contribution receipt for the current value of the reservation fee will be provided for the year of return.
- All monies received for burial plots will go into the Cemetery Endowment Fund. Interest from this fund will be used for cemetery maintenance.
- No burial plot may be opened until full payment for that space is made. Funeral directors are to contact the church office to confirm burial plot assignment.
- A vault is required for each burial plot.
- No curbing, rock covering or any other ground coverings (other than flower holders) may be placed in the cemetery. Grass is the only acceptable ground cover for both graves and burial plots.
- No flowers, shrubs, or trees shall be planted within the confines of the cemetery. Persons placing flowers on graves are responsible for removing them before they become unsightly. The caretaker is authorized to remove dead and unsightly flowers.
- The Cemetery Committee must approve the size, design and placement of all structures in the cemetery. Headstones and footstones must be extended at least 5 inches above the ground to allow proper cemetery maintenance.
- The Cemetery Committee is pleased to serve you and the Church. We are indebted to those members before us who gave their time, energy and money so that Main Street United Methodist Church would have a peaceful and properly maintained final resting place for our departed members. Your support will be greatly appreciated.

## ADDENDUM GOVERNING MAUSOLEUMS

- The Cemetery Committee reserves the right of final approval of size, design and placement of all structures. Dimensional plans to scale must be submitted for approval prior to construction.
- Units must be fully supported by a concrete slab footing of at least four (4) inches thickness which is at finished grade on at least 50% of its perimeter. The footing may extend beyond the unit foundation up to four (4) inches on any side.
